Speak Kadazan at home, families told

PENAMPANG: Kadazandusun Cultural Association (KDCA) President Tan Sri Joseph Pairin said it can be the platform to unite and empower the Kadazandusun without bounded by differences in religion, political ideology or social status.

"Race is transcends religion and politics. Religion and political allegiance may change but not race. A race is identified by its culture. You lose *Koubasanan* then you lose Kadazandusun," he said at the KDCA 12th Triennial Delegates' Conference in Hongkod Koisaan

Towards this end, Pairin said the uniqueness of KDCA is that its members comprised individuals from various ethnic groups, religion and political ideology can sit in one table to discuss ways to preserve culture, customs and other things for mutual benefits.

activities, is interested to venture into real estate development and commercial agriculture.

Koisaan Bhd, which is a co-operative for them.

Curren'tly involved in several businesses including palm oil plantation, he said, adding that the Koperasi Serbaguna Koisaan Bhd could be among the biggest cooperative in the country, if all KDCA members also become its members.

Pairin said an organisational and management audits would be done on KDCA to ensure it remained relevant to time and circumstances so that it can bring huge benefit to its

members. "We are in the process of transforming KDCA ... the process will review the effectiveness of the structure and delivery system as well as management of KDCA," he said.

Meanwhile, KDCA Secretary General Suman Yasambun announced that there was also no contest for the 11 central committee posts after six other nominees withdrew their candidacy.
